The scholarship fund is named in honor of Barbara C. Beazley who founded the organization and is a tribute to her lifelong commitment to helping children in Columbia County. Barbara Beazley served as a role model for many years to the Columbia County community. Raised from humble beginnings in North Carolina, she got her first job at age 10. She has been described as a quick and avid learner, self-reliant, a brilliant business woman, and a dedicated community leader. Mrs. Beazley had an exceptional talent for remembering names, faces, facts, and figures. Her strong work ethic served as a role model for employees and for all who knew her. Mrs. Beazley served in leadership positions with the Builders Association of Metro Augusta, the Home Builders Association of Georgia and the Columbia County Republican Party. She recognized many years ago the need in Columbia County for an organization to provide services to children and families and with community support from business professionals and government leaders, the Columbia County Foundation for Children was established and continues to serve the community.

The Board of Directors for Columbia County Foundation for Children (CCFC) awards need-based educational scholarships for education beyond high school. Scholarships are awarded to Columbia County residents, based on an applicant's demonstrated financial need, personal statements, interview, and written recommendation. The Foundation is a 501(c) (3) nonprofit. Applicants may be up to age 22 and must be accepted into or currently attending college.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

1. This is a financial needs based scholarship. It is not a merit scholarship program. Applicants must fully explain and document their financial need. Deadline to submit all applications and supporting documents is Friday, May 3, 2019. Applications received after the deadline or with incomplete or missing documents cannot be considered.
2. Applicants may receive assistance from family members or other third parties to complete the application with exception of the personal statement. The applicant must complete the personal statement themselves. Applicants must provide accurate financial information to be eligible for the scholarship. Any applicant purposefully omitting or providing inaccurate information about family financial status or assistance shall be ineligible for the scholarship.
3. Any change in enrollment status, program of study, or institution will need to be submitted to the Foundation.

4. If applicants have questions about the application, supporting documents, or qualifications for assistance the applicant may email the Scholarship Coordinator at ccfchildrenscholarships@gmail.com or visit Columbia County Foundation for Children website at <http://www.ccfchildren.org>.
5. Notification of the status of scholarship applications will be sent via email or by usps. Scholarship determinations will not be made until after the deadline for submissions.

7. This is a needs based scholarship program. It is not a merit based scholarship. The current general income guidelines are 250% of the federal poverty guidelines illustrated below.

8. Scholarship awards range from \$500 to \$2,000. The median award for 2018-2019 school year was \$1,000 with an average award of \$1,146.

2. Print the estimated total yearly costs of attending your college or tech school for 2019-2020 from the official college website.
3. Print a copy of your most recent 2019-2020 Student Financial Aid Award letter from your college describing all aid offered.
4. Print a copy of your tax return (if employed) and your family's federal income tax returns for 2018; include schedules and supporting documents. Georgia State returns are not required.
5. Submit an official copy of your high school or college transcript with seal or signature.
6. Submit a letter of recommendation (New Applicants)
7. Attach your personal statement
