College Scholarship Program

The foundation has a Barbara C. Beazley memorial scholarship fund as well as a CTAE scholarship fund. For the 2019-2020 school year, we have awarded \$36,000 in scholarships to 30 students. The median award was \$1,000. Scholarship recipients are attending Augusta State, Augusta Tech, East Georgia State College, Georgia Tech, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, Johnson & Wales, Kennesaw State, Emory University, SCAD, University of Georgia, and York Technical College. We wish all the students well and look forward to hearing an update from them when they apply for the renewal of their scholarship.

During the Christmas holidays, children of families referred by the Columbia County school system and social service agencies are sponsored for holiday gifts. Local schools, businesses, churches and families donate Christmas gifts to include clothing, toys, shoes, school supplies and various other items to bring joy and comfort to these families during the holidays. Thru the generosity of community sponsors the Christmas Program assisted 211 families with a total of 610 children. The Foundation sponsored 37 children.

Helping Hands Thrift Store We are Accepting Donations

CCFFC operates the Helping Hands Thrift Store. Family clothing is provided free of charge to Columbia County residents in need who are referred by the Department of Family and Children Services, schools, or churches. Other items may be available on request.



The store is open to the public for low cost clothing and household goods purchases. Donations of new and slightly used family clothing, furniture and household items are welcomed.

Tax-deductible receipts are available.

Proceeds from the store support the CCFFC Scholarship and Benevolence programs. Through our referral program for 2018, we assisted 50 referrals with a total of 143 members.

Pantry Project

Can you imagine not having access to underwear or socks? What about sanitary napkins, deodorant, or shampoo? These basic hygiene items are inaccessible to many of the children in Columbia County. The Pantry Project was started several years ago to address this need. Thanks to the support of business leaders and members of the community, we have been able to collect and distribute 1,814 items to elementary, middle, and high schools.

The most requested items for the 2018-2019 school year were underwear (451 pair), deodorant (160), toothbrushes (131), and sanitary napkins (74 pkgs). Other items distributed include shampoo, soap, washcloths, baby wipes, brushes, combs, toothpaste, socks, etc.
